

BIRKENHEAD PHOTO COMPETITION 2026: PHOTO REQUIREMENTS, TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- The Organiser is Highbury Community House Incorporated.
- Each photograph submitted constitutes one Entry.
- Entries will be open from Saturday 19th September 2026 through to midnight on Friday 16th October 2026. No late Entries will be accepted.
- The photograph must be taken in, of, or from Birkenhead, Auckland.
- Each person may submit up to three Entries. If more than three Entries are submitted, only the first three Entries will be accepted.
- Photographs must have been taken within one year before the date of entry.
- Entries may originate as digital photos or film but must be submitted in electronic form.
- Only Entries submitted via the Organiser's Online Entry Form will be accepted.
- All Entries must be in JPEG or JPG format and at least 1600 pixels wide or 1600 pixels tall.
- Each photograph must be no more than 5mb in size.
- The entire photograph must be a single work of original material taken by the Entrant. By entering, the Entrant asserts that the submitted photograph is an original work created exclusively by the Entrant and that the photograph does not infringe on the copyrights, trademarks or intellectual property rights of any person or entity, and that no other person or entity has any right, title, claim, or interest in the photograph.
- The Entrant declares that they have the permission of all individual(s) captured in a photograph(s) to share and publish their image. Large group shots are exempt.
- Entrants shall ensure that photographs containing sculptures or any other art do not infringe on any person or entities rights.
- The caption must be complete; misrepresenting the origin of the Entrant's content is cause for disqualification.
- Photographs with watermarks are ineligible.
- Entries must be fit for public display (no nudity, drug or alcohol use, or illegal activities). The Organiser reserves the right to remove any Entry it deems inappropriate.
- The Organiser and Judging Panel reserve the right to move an Entry into a different category from which they were entered.
- The Youth Category is open to Entrants aged 14 and under at the time the competition entries close.
- Winners will be selected by a judging panel whose decision is final. No correspondence will be entered into about the Judges decisions.
- Winners will be notified as soon as practicable after judging, and the Entrant agrees to attend in person to receive their prize at the Organiser's or Sponsor's premises within a reasonable time following notification.
- The Entrant acknowledges that Entries will be displayed publicly, including on the Organiser's website and other social media forums. The Entrant gives the Organiser and competition Sponsors permission to use the photograph(s) and the Entrant's name, for future promotional activities of the Competition. Consent of the Entrant for use of the photograph(s) for promotion of the Birkenhead area unrelated to this Competition shall be sought from the Entrant, and the Entrant consents to the Organiser sharing their contact details with Sponsor(s) for this purpose. The Organiser and Sponsor(s) agree to provide the Entrant with attribution where feasible.
- The Entrant agrees to be added to the Organiser's Newsletter mailing list, to which they may unsubscribe at a later date should they wish.

In submitting an Entry or Entries to the Birkenhead Photo Competition 2026, the Entrant (or their legal guardian) accepts the terms and conditions outlined above.
